

NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF A CRIMINAL COMPLAINT



This NOTICE is to advise you *(name of subject)*.....

that as per the **Reporting Obligations of the Criminal Justice Act 2011** that you have been reported to the Statutory Authorities and named in a formal criminal complaint copied to An Garda Síochána HQ; to the Office of the DPP; to the Minister for Justice; and to the *Integrity Ireland HAFTA Database* in matters generally summarised as follows:

You are further advised that any attempts to interfere with or obstruct the lawful submission and advancement of the aforesaid complaint, or any attempts to suppress or otherwise improperly conceal said complaint in face of the supporting evidence and/or in context of the sworn affidavit of the complainant would constitute an offence against **Section 7 of the Criminal Procedure Act 2010** specifically; “an offence against the administration of justice” which is an arrestable offence. Accordingly, any parties so involved or who are implicated in affiliated unlawful or unconstitutional activities such as misfeasance, malfeasance or nonfeasance (especially by Statutory Authorities or their agents) may be subject to a criminal complaint and/or a citizen’s arrest under **Section 4 of the Criminal Law Act 1997** whereupon said parties will be delivered to An Garda Síochána for the purposes of surrendering to due process as provided for in legislation.
