*MISSION STATEMENT

- (i) **The Peoples Tribunal of Ireland** is an initiative by residents and citizens of the Irish State to lawfully address persistent, widespread, endemic lapses and failures of the Irish State to adhere to the Rule of Law in respect of fundamental human rights, and in particular to provide for the individual's right to access justice.
- (ii) **To provide for the impartial and objective assessment** and/or investigation of issues, events, actions, questions, enquiries and/or cases which are pertinent to the constitutional integrity of Irish society and to the lawful status of sovereign Irish people.
- (iii) To provide some manner of authoritative, documented redress for aggrieved citizens/residents which is; (a) honest, fair, objective and impartial; (b) that is independent of government and vested interests; and (c) which is constructed and composed in express alignment with internationally-recognised human rights law, and with EU and domestic law, in strict order of legal precedence according to existing positive law.
- (iv) **To aid in the determination of legal certainty** by providing for the production and publication of qualified written mandates in the form of PTI Judicial Orders, Rulings, Findings Directives and/or Decrees to be binding on the parties served, according to the Rule of Law.
- (v) **To provide for a People's Prosecution Service** in support of the individual's right to initiate and prosecute criminal proceedings in the Irish Courts under *S.10 of the Petty Sessions (Ireland) Act 1851* and to provide for the active and effective implementation of existing citizens' arrest powers as laid out under *S.4 of the Criminal Law Act 1997*.
- (vi) To provide for independent, qualified arbitration and mediation services.
- (vii) **To provide an open public forum** for residents, citizens and all interested parties to contribute to and learn from the collective experience and expertise of the PTI Membership, in open collaboration with any and all other relevant, pertinent or applicable sources, resources, groups or institutions whether statutory, private and/or independent for the purposes outlined herein.
